60 Artists To Exhibit At Beth El Festival

According to chairmen Mr. and Mrs. Albert Zeitlin, exciting plans are well under way for Beth El's Festival of Israeli Art, opening April 22 and running through April 27.

This year's show, in Beth El auditorium, will display the talents of over 60 Israeli artists whose works are being sent directly from Israel through cooperation of the Safari Gallery in Jerusalem/Boston.

AMONG THE ARTISTS represented are Chagall, Moshe Gat, Rbin, Stern, Casteel, Bezem and Soviet Jewish artist Anatole Kaplan. A collection devoted to the theme of peace features works by Sgaga Weil, David Sharir and others.

The collection is in the fields of original oils, watercolors, sculpture, pottery, batiks, glass and jewelry, with prices ranging from \$10 to \$3,000.

ADMISSION to the champagne preview on Saturday evening, Apr. 22, will be through advance sponsorship in four categories: Angel — \$300, Benefactor — \$100, Patron — \$50, Sponsor — \$25. In conjunction with the newly established Beth El Museum of Judaica, donors in the Angel category will be named as charter founders; benefactors, as founders.
